Purpose

Our purpose is to provide fellowship and teaching to the women that can flow into every aspect of their lives.

Time Requirements

- Volunteers meet monthly for training and development.
- Schedules are flexible based on the volunteer's availability.

Qualifications Needed

- Co-chairperson—responsible for attending 1st Sat. meetings at least four times during the year, assisting with the fellowship and teaching on the 4th Sat. of the month, assisting with planned events, and serve as back-up to chairperson.
- Event Coordinator---responsible for calling potential speakers and informing the church secretary of the need to send out correspondence to speakers or invitations to events, researching activities for the fellowship, planning activities and events.
- Secretary—responsible for taking notes and attendance at meetings and making sure that the chairperson and co-chairperson has a copy of the meeting notes prior to the 1st Sat. of the month, obtaining current e-mail addresses for women of the church, calling when unexpected situations occur, and making sure that announcements relating to the fellowship are posted in a timely manner.
- Meal Coordinator –responsible for overseeing meals served at or by the fellowship (these are usually limited to only six to seven times a year), setting up and break down at meetings or events where meals are served.
